Abstract: Julia "Judy" Earnestine Ware was born in 1918 to Earnest Harry Ware

and Julia May Byers and she died in 1988. She had one son, Harry James Johnston-Bishop, and two grandchildren: Kimberly and Timothy. Judy spent her life as a freelance artist. Her art was featured on phonebooks, in downtown Fort Smith banks as a mural, and she was commissioned to do various pieces. Her specialty was oil paintings of animals and old historic paintings where she took an old photograph and painted a replica of it. This collection contains Judy's family photos in albums and scrapbooks,

ephemera, and her portfolio along with two framed paintings.

Processing Information: The collection was donated in good condition, but in disarray. There

appeared to be distinct divisions in the materials: photographs,

memorabilia, and Judy Ware-Bishop's artwork. The photographs were

loose, so they were initially placed in an archive folder. Later, the photos were sorted by person and their age, to the best of our ability. The photos were labeled if it was clear who it is with a Copy Not NP Blue pencil then placed in protective sleeves. There was a picnic basket that was also donated but was removed from the collection due to it being damaged. The collection was processed by Mary Carson and Rachel Sanford in March 2023.

Collection Details

Biographical Note:

Julia "Judy" Earnestine Ware was born on July 28, 1918, in Fort Smith Arkansas and died on July 17, 1988, in Fort Smith, Arkansas. Judy spent her life as an artist, she taught classes and was commissioned to do paintings and murals.

Judy married her first husband, George McLaughlin in 1934 and was divorced within two years. Her second husband was James Harley Johnston. They got married in 1936, and they had one child, Harry James Johnston in 1941. After their divorce in 1949, Judy married James H. Bishop in 1950. They were married for 12 years when they got divorced in 1962. Judy went by Judy Ware Bishop for the rest of her life.

Judy's mother is Julia May Byers born December 12, 1898, to James C. Byers and Margaret Ellen Baker, she died on August 9, 1986. Her father is Earnest Harrison "Harry" Ware, born September 29, 1891, to John Henry Ware and Margaret Jane Snodgrass, he died on August 30, 1968. Judy's maternal grandmother Margaret Ellen Baker was born on February 26, 1877 to Billie Baker and Julia Ann McCabe, and she died on January 6, 1962.

Judy's son Harry James Johnston went by Harry James Bishop all his life. He married Anita Duncan in 1940 and they had two children: Kimberly "Kim" Kaye Bishop and Timothy "Timmy" Wayne Bishop. Harry James Johnston-Bishop died April 17, 1965.

Scope and Content:

The records for the Judy Ware-Bishop family collection include family photo albums, ephemera, and Judy's art portfolio. The strength of the collection is the family photos and the art portfolio.

The "Photo Albums" series ranges from 1890 to 1987 and includes five albums and 67 pages of loose photos. Photographs include Judy, her son and his wife, her grandchildren, her parents, grandparents, and great grandparents, along with many unidentified people. Some photographs were labeled, others were labeled during the processing of this collection using the labels there to identify the same person.

The "Ephemera" series contains Judy's father's wallet, newspaper clippings, copyright registration for art, invitation, card, and Judy's funeral home memorial book. This series ranges from 1918 to 1988.

The "Judy Ware-Bishop" series contains her portfolio and two framed paintings, ranging from 1933 to 1984. The portfolio is photographs of her paintings, and inspiration for her art, all in scrapbook format.

System of Arrangement: This collection is organized into three series: "Series 1. Photo Albums,"

"Series 2. Ephemera," and "Series 3. Judy Ware-Bishop Artwork."

The loose photographs within the Photo Album series are arranged with Judy's grandchildren: Kim and Timmy first, then Judy's son Harry

James Johnston-Bishop, followed by Judy, then her parents,

grandparents, and unknown people are last. The labels that we created

listed the people with their maiden name.
