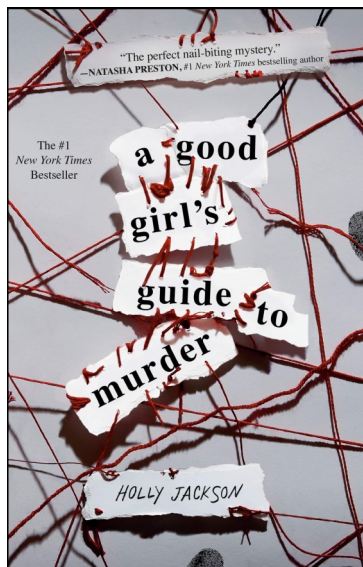




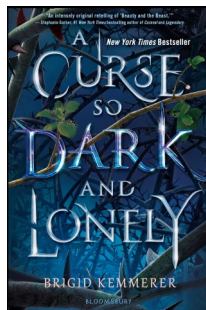
Arkansas Teen Book Award Winners Level 2 (Grades 10-12)
