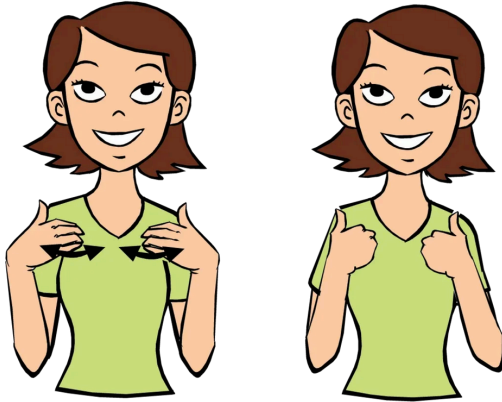
Where Is Brown Bear?
