If You're Happy

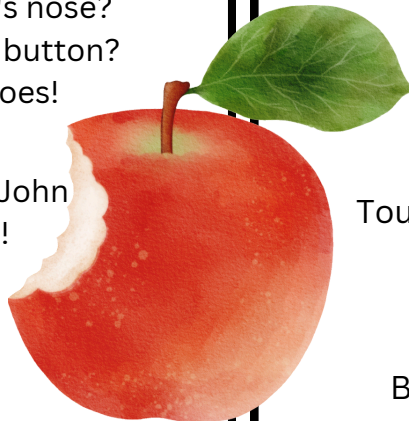
If you're happy and you know it

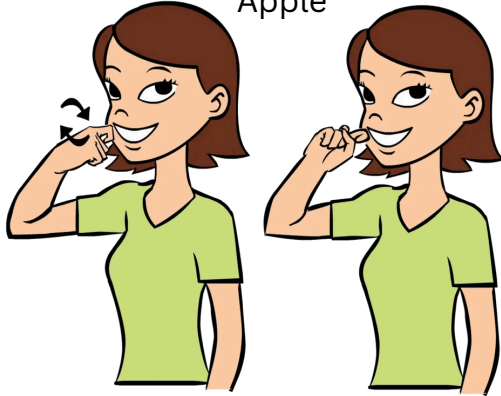
