4) This is the way we rinse our hair...



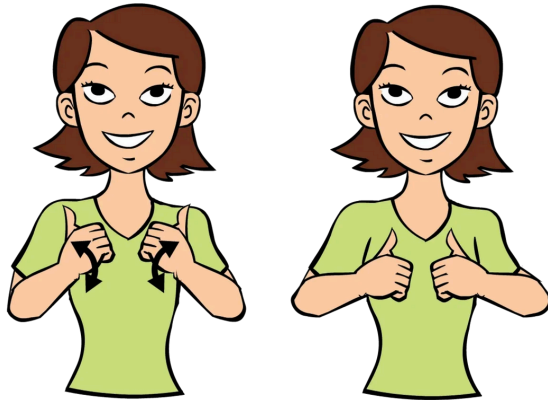
