"Mooooove over!"

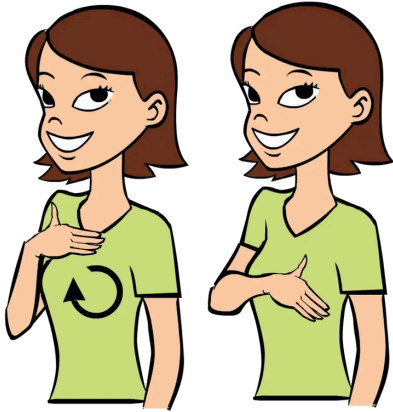
