Round and round it goes!



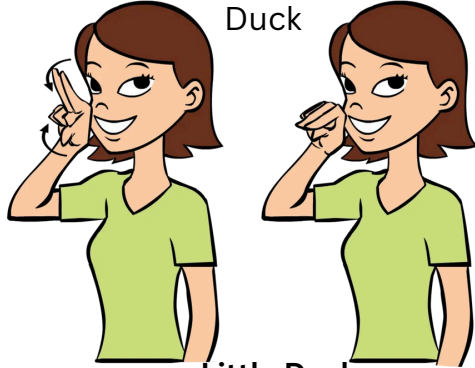
