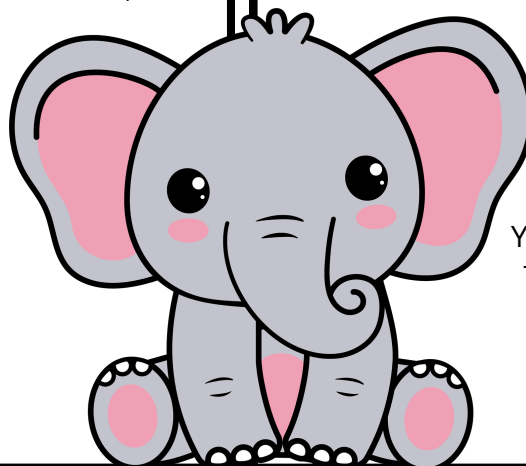
Head and shoulders, knees and toes,

Kiss me here.



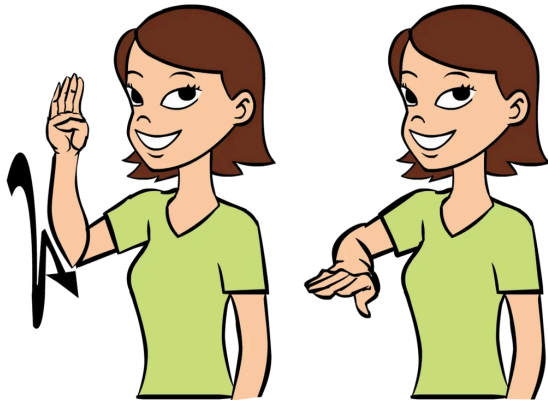

Goodbye, goodbye,

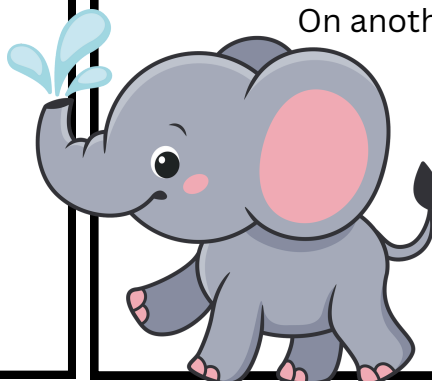
