Lay them in your lap, lap, lap.

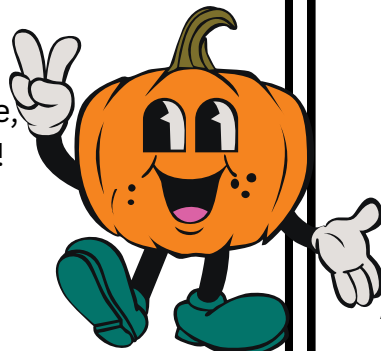
Creep them, crawl them,
