Come back, Jill. *(bring left finger back)*



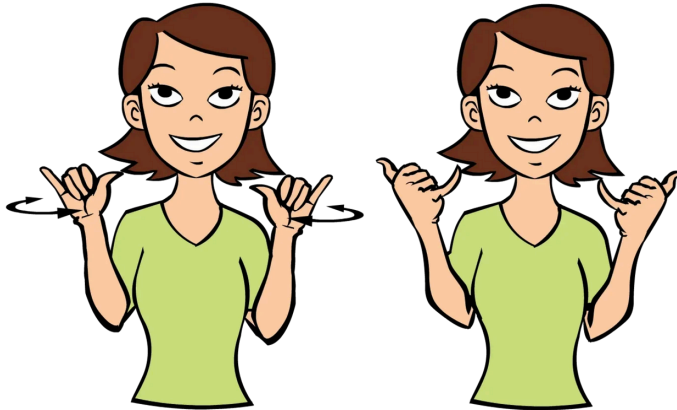
