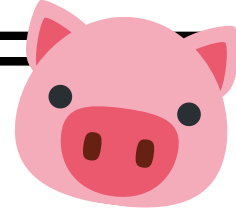

All the way home!

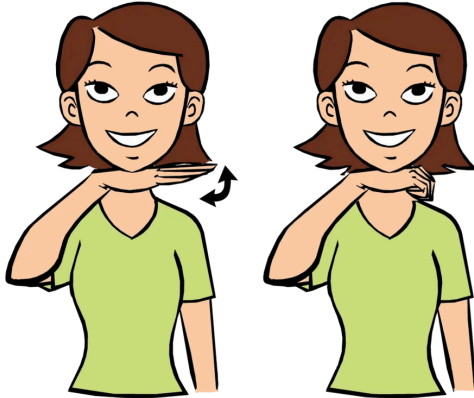
