- 3) Blow a kiss.





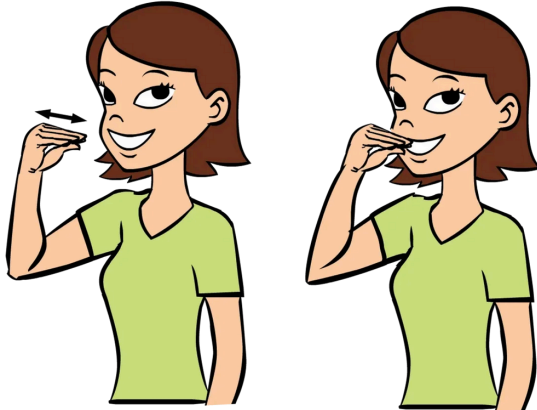
