If You're Happy

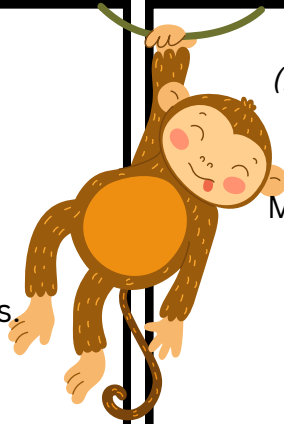
If you're happy and you know it

tree!

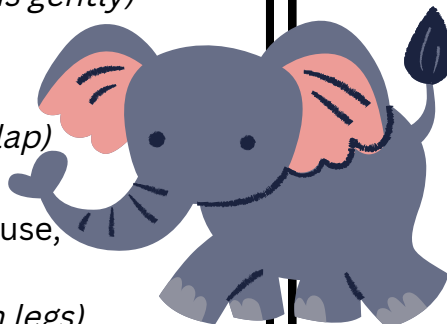
(Open palms wide and clap loudly)

3) Bear/Growl



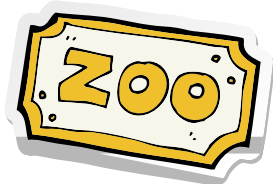
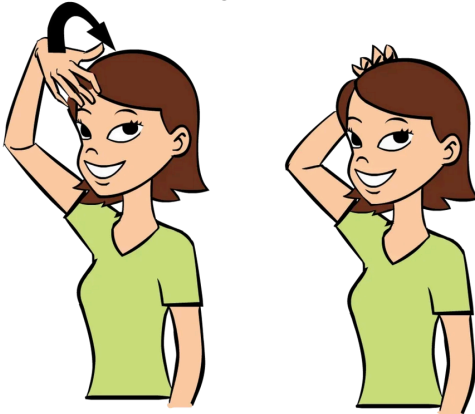
